

Ice Breaker/Grouping

Objectives

- An innovative method to encourage group interaction in small groups of similar size.
- Interactive alternative to numbering participants.

Supplies: none needed

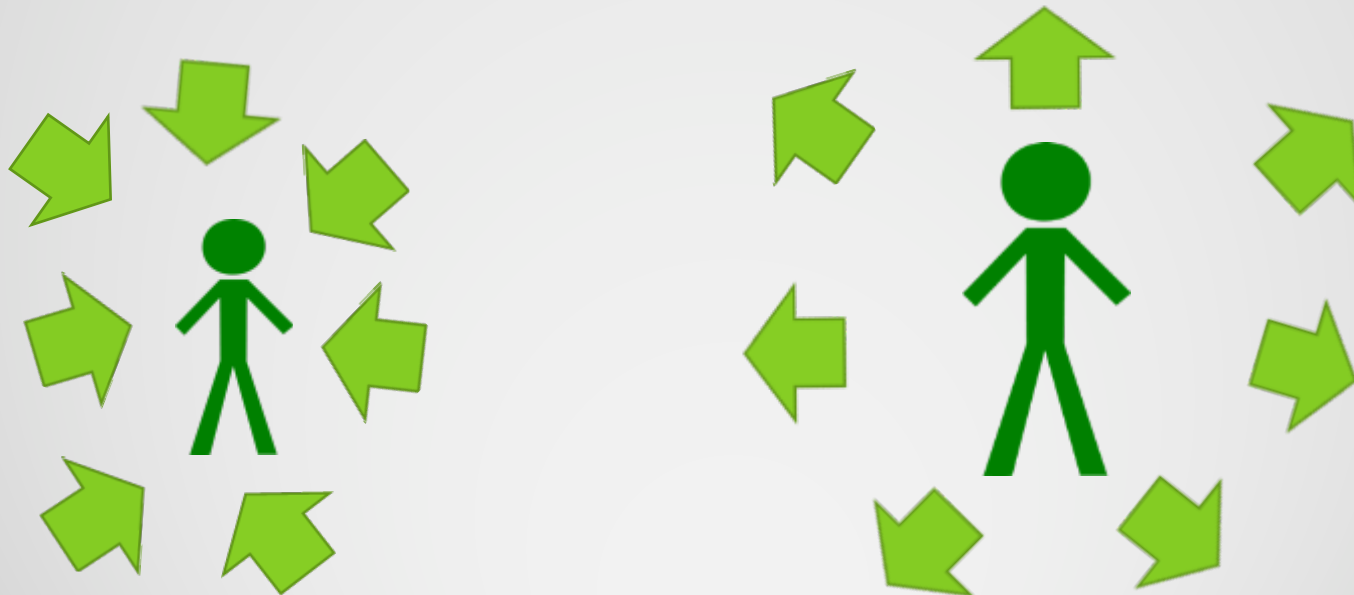
